One registration allows the submission of 2 papers (max 9 pages each for regular orally presented papers; max 4 pages for posters).

To be published in the IEEE/ACM IWQOS 2012 Conference Proceedings and IEEE Xplore®, at least one Author of an accepted paper is required to register for the conference at the full ComSoc or ACM Member, IEEE or Sister Society Member or Non-Member Rate and the paper must be presented at the workshop. Non-refundable registration fees must be paid prior to uploading the final IEEE formatted, publication ready version of the paper. For authors with multiple accepted papers, one full registration is valid for up to two (2) workshop papers. Please do not share your registration confirmation code with anyone else. Although the code enables submission of up to two papers, it can only be used once, by you, to create an Author account. Accepted and presented papers will be published in the IEEE/ACM IWQOS 2012 Conference Proceedings and in IEEE Xplore®. IEEE reserves the right to exclude a paper from distribution after the conference (e.g., removal from IEEE Xplore®) if the paper is not presented at the conference.
